

## Potential Leader Checklist

Ask the following questions to evaluate a potential leader. Give marks from 10 (excellent) to 1 (very low) to describe the person. This chart can be used for comparison among potential leaders. The higher the score, the stronger the person's leadership ability.

Category	Questions	Marks (1-10)
1. Spiritual Maturity A. Character  B. Growth  C. Response to authority  D. Spiritual Gifts	<p>Is he/she spiritually qualified for the position? (1 Timothy 3:1-13; Titus 1:5-9)</p> <p>Character flaws to look for: -Failure to take responsibility for actions and mistakes -Unfulfilled promises -Failure to meet deadlines.</p> <p>How has the person grown in his/her faith? Is he/she taking advantage of growth opportunities such as seminars, Bible studies, and discipleship courses? Is he/she praying? Learning the Word?</p> <p>Is this person willing to be corrected? How does he/she speak about leaders? Is he/she accountable to you?</p> <p>Is his/her spiritual gift obvious?</p>	
2. Influence	Is this person influencing others?	
3. People skills	Are people attracted to him/her? Does he/she know how to talk nicely to people? Can he/she correct others with a smile?	
4. Problem-solving ability	What problems have I seen this person solve? Does this person give good ideas for positive change?	
5. Self-discipline Time Temper Tongue	<p>How does the person use his/her time?</p> <p>Does the person have control of his/her emotions?</p> <p>How does the person talk?</p>	
6. Self-image	Does he/she have self-confidence?	
7. Attitude	Does he/she have a good attitude?
